WHEREAS, this year marks the 28th Annual DC Black Pride Weekend hosted by Black Lesbian and Gay Pride Day, Incorporated; and

WHEREAS, this annual event brings over 50,000 participants together to increase awareness of pride and promote diversity throughout the Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender and Queer (LGBTQ) community; and



WHEREAS, the African-American LGBTQ community is dedicated to ensuring access to health care related services for individuals living with HIV/AIDS, addressing women's health issues, and facilitating appropriate services for LGBTQ elders; and

WHEREAS, this year's theme, "Communities Together Building Communities," reinforces the commitment of the African-American LGBTQ community to combat all violence directed toward LGBTQ individuals, and ensure that the nation remains a safe place for all regardless of their sexual orientation; and
